



# Wellness Plan

At Dance Depot the safety and security of our employees, dancers, families and local community is our utmost priority.

We will pay close attention to the news of the coronavirus and its impact on the community. We will take action based on guidance from public health experts and the CDC to ensure safety for all of our dance families. We may also follow the lead of the School Board of Lake County.

## **Our Hygiene Policy**

- When deemed necessary:
  - Dancers will be asked health questions
  - Temperatures will be taken before entering the building.
  - We will encourage students to distance whenever possible.

## Ongoing Protocols:

- Masks are strongly encouraged for non dancers entering the building.
- Dancers are not required to wear masks while dancing. We encourage parents to do what they feel is best for their family. If you choose to have your dancer wear a mask we support that decision completely. Please send them to class in their mask and instruct them to leave it in place. Taking the mask off and on will not be permitted.
- The lobby may be closed to non dancers for waiting.

## **Our Schedule**

Our class schedule will have a 5 minute buffer. This will give us an opportunity to have dancers exit and enter the building with less congestion. Please stick to the schedule and be on time.

## **Our Facility**

As always, we will maintain a clean studio. We will also be following a daily disinfecting protocol to help preserve the wellness of our families. Our offices will be open and we will be available by email and phone. We ask that parents observe safe distances when in our facilities. We encourage families to congregate freely in the outdoors.
